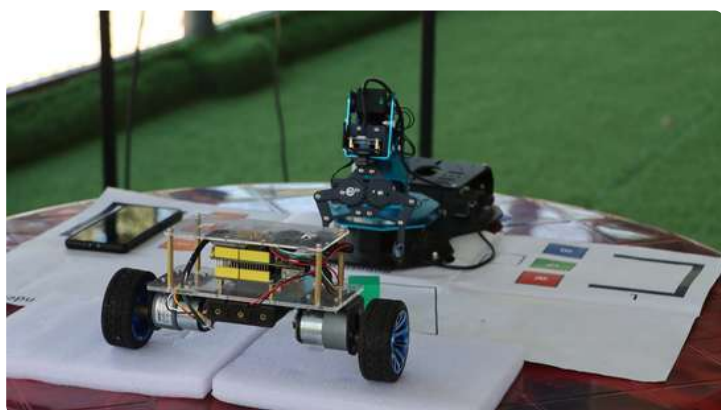
Industry Insights: Exploring CG Park

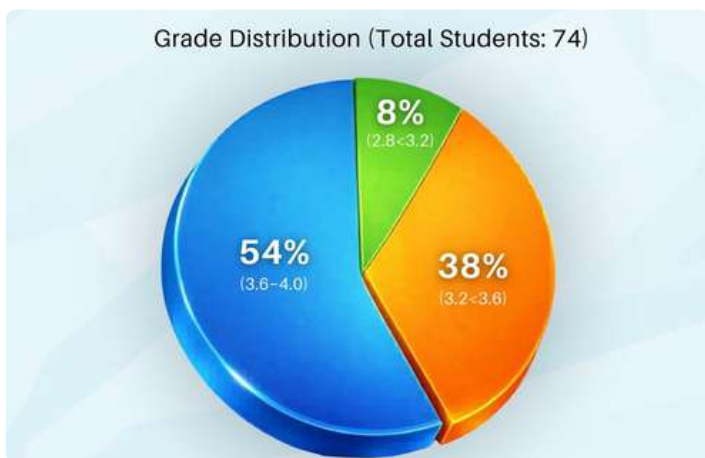
Big Ideas, Bright Futures: Business Pitch Vol. 1.0

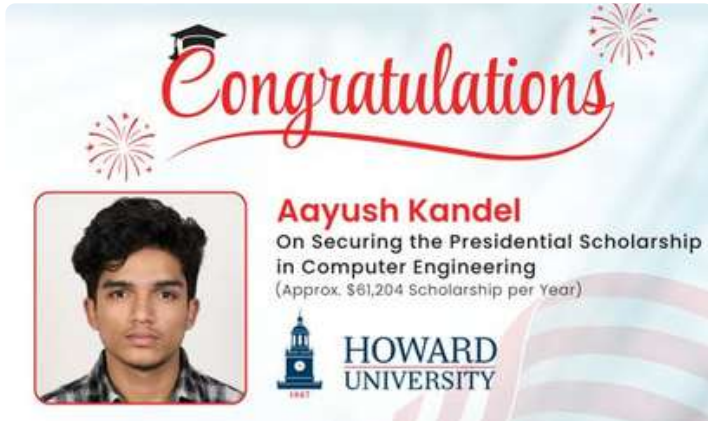
Charting the Future: Career Compass 2026
